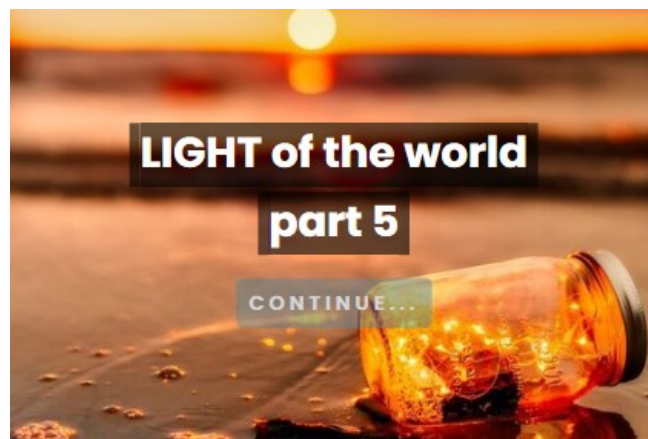
The Stebbings
